Method ①

Issuance by Scanning QR Code

Visit the Eup, Dong, or Myeon Community Center(Administrative Welfare Center) to apply for mobile Resident Registration Card issuance, and scan the QR code displayed by the responsible official to receive the mobile Resident Registration Card.



Method ②

Direct Issuance with an IC Resident Registration Card

Apply for and receive a physical Resident Registration Card with a built-in IC chip, and tag the IC Resident Registration Card to your phone in your own name to receive the mobile Resident Registration Card.

Regulations Related to Driving Uninsured Vehicles and Unauthorized Abandonment

- **When driving a vehicle without subscribing to mandatory car insurance**
 - ① Vehicle owner is subject to imprisonment for up to 1 year or a fine of up to 10 million won
 - * However, in the case of a single offense of driving without car insurance, it can be replaced with a penalty fine
 - ② Penalty fine for driving without car insurance (Article 50 and 51 of the Automobile Damage Compensation Guarantee Act)

- **If a vehicle is left abandoned on roads or another's land and forcibly scrapped**
 - ① The vehicle owner (possessor) is subject to imprisonment of up to 1 year or a fine of up to 10 million won.
 - * However, if there is only 1 instance of a vehicle abandonment crime, it can be replaced with a fine.
 - ② Vehicle abandonment fine (Motor Vehicle Management Act Articles 85, 86)



Disposal Location: In front of your house/store

General Waste Please dispose of waste in standard general waste bags! Vegetables: Roots of green onions, Welsh onions, water parsley, etc., peels of onions, garlic, ginger, corn, etc., chili seeds, chili stems, corn stalks Meat: Hair and bones of cows, pigs, chickens, etc. Seafood: Shellfish shells, crustacean shells, fish bones Fruits: Hard shells of walnuts, chestnuts, pineapples, etc., seeds of apricots, peaches, persimmons, etc. Eggshells: chicken, duck Other residues such as coffee, green tea, herbal medicine	Food Waste Please squeeze out moisture and remove as much water as possible before disposal! - Apartment Buildings: RFID disposal - Detached Houses: RFID or designated collection container (standard bag) disposal Fruits: Fruit peels such as apples, oranges, bananas, Korean melons, watermelons, etc. Vegetables: Vegetable trimming remnants such as cabbage, Korean cabbage, etc. Others: Sauced, salted seafood, soybean paste, red pepper paste, kimchi (rinse with water before disposal), etc. *Please remove foreign substances such as plastic bags, wooden chopsticks, etc!
Large Waste Please purchase and attach a disposal sticker before disposal! Purchase: Visit a community center/Yeongdeungpo-gu Office website/mobile app 'Ebeigi' - Bedding (blankets, pillows) and furniture (wardrobes, desks, sofas, beds) - Suitcases, children's toys, cutting boards, earthquake pots, flower pots, simulators, bicycles, picture frames, rubber tubs, exercise equipment, toilets, drying racks, etc	Others Please dispose of in special refuse bags! (Purchase: Search on the Yeongdeungpo-gu Office website) - Porcelain: ceramicware - Heat-resistant glass: broken glass lids - Small amounts of home repair debris - Soil: cat litter, pruning debris with leaves

A fine of up to 1 million won will be imposed for mixed disposal with general waste and violations of disposal times.
